CHALK meets during the Sunday morning service at the South Door at the start of the Gloria, before starting their activities in the

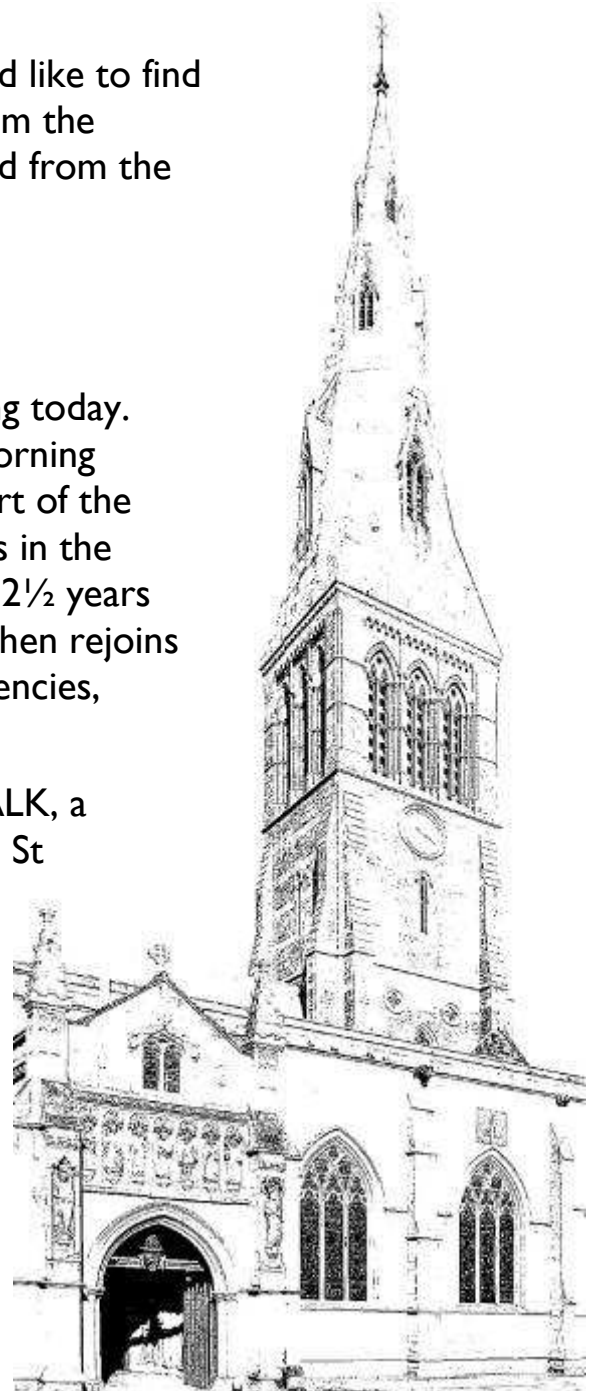
